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

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Workshop Description

Anchored In Truth

Educators have an eternal calling - to serve as anchors of truth, grounding the families and little ones entrusted to our care. Learn four principles of truth that can anchor us and the children and families we serve. Apply these truths to pressing questions about healthy attachment, fear and anxiety, brain development, and challenging behaviors. Learn research-driven truth on the critical needs of the developing child's brain and ways to counter a child's fears. Evaluate how you approach a child's dysregulated behavior and gain skills for healthy social and emotional health using the Pyramid Approach. Finally, create problem-solving activities for your class that will benefit brain development in multiple ways. Engage these specific practices for helping those in our early education community flourish.

9:00 AM SESSION 1: Combat Negative Impacts of Current Family Trends with Truth

Learn to identify anxiety-driven trends that negatively impact healthy child development, explore research-based truths to alleviate common fears about young children's needs, and evaluate effective ideas for parent events and communications that foster a deeper understanding of healthy early childhood development.

Be guided in constructing a model of a preschool child's brain to highlight its critical needs, identifying key adult behaviors essential for healthy development and understanding their importance. Develop a list of practical actions to implement and review methods for training parents to adopt these critical behaviors for supporting young children's growth.

Explore the five tiers of the Pyramid Model for fostering social and emotional health in young children. We will assess the school's alignment with the model, and create scenarios that demonstrate responsive interactions and positive social lessons in preschool, with the opportunity to act out a few of these scenarios for practical application.


2:30 PM SESSION 4: Freedom - Another Ingredient for True Developmental Growth


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
