## **Workshop Description**

#### Anchored: Language and Literacy Development in Early Childhood

Let's translate literacy research into practice through introducing teachers to a variety of hands-on activities that teachers can implement in their classrooms during large group, small group, centers, and individual instruction. Teachers will learn strategies in language development, phonological awareness, and letter knowledge to provide children with optimal literacy learning experiences using planned, purposeful, and playful strategies.

#### 9:00 AM SESSION 1: Connecting Through Talk

God designed us to speak! How do we help children develop a rich vocabulary? How do children learn language? Experience is the key! This session will engage you in discussing and exploring strategies to design language-rich classrooms and scaffold children's language development.

#### 10:15 AM SESSION 2: Understanding About Sounds

What is phonological awareness and how do you teach it to young children? By immersing children in playing with language and sounds throughout the day. This session will provide an overview of the phonological awareness continuum and activities to support children's development at each level.

#### 12:45 PM SESSION 3: Alphabet Knowledge

The question is not "Should we teach the alphabet?" but "How should we teach the alphabet?" Engage in purposeful, fun-filled letter activities designed to support developing alphabet knowledge. Discuss how planed experiences and capitalizing on teachable moments help children learn about the alphabet.







