Session Description

Anchored: Designing Learning Experiences that Unleash Student Thinking through Inquiry and God's Word

To unleash student thinking, we must first anchor our lessons in God's word and understand our children have been wired to inquire. When we begin designing lessons that start with sparking wonder and curiosity, children want to learn and know the mysteries of God. Learning is enriched when we intentionally make meaningful connections between the content, we throughout our day while using play as a vehicle to engage children in the learning process. Lastly, when we build in the right scaffolds and strategies, all children can learn.

At the end of this session, you will be able answer how your classroom can be a place for fostering wonder and curiosity while pointing children to God.

12:45 PM SESSION 3: Meaningful Play and Student Choice


