## **Transportation Options**

# **Taxi (Most Convenient Option)**

- Convenient and readily available outside the airport.
- · Costs:

Airport to/from Palma: €40 - €60

o Palma city center: €25 - €30

- Travel Time: ~23 min (28.9km)
- Identifiable by white color with red and yellow stripes.
- Uses taximeters; extra fees apply for airport trips, late nights, and luggage.
- Tips:
  - Carry cash (euros) in small bills.
  - o Always check the meter is running.
  - Calling a taxi from a phone adds a €1.10 surcharge.
  - Tipping isn't required but appreciated (round up or 10%).
  - Ask for a receipt in case you need to track your ride.

# **Bus (Cheapest Option)**

• Travel time: ~1 hour.

• Cost: €4 - €10.

- Route:
  - Take Line A1 from the airport to Palma Intermodal Station.
  - Switch to Line 104 or 107 to reach Magaluf.
- Tickets available via bus driver (credit card), online, or ticket machines.
- Things to consider:
  - Check seasonal schedules on the <u>TIB</u> website.
  - Not ideal for heavy luggage or late-night arrivals.

### Uber

- Cost: €30 €60.
- Book via the app upon arrival.

## **Private Transfer (Most Expensive Option)**

- Pre-booked service with flexible scheduling.
- Costs: €65 €100.
- More expensive than taxis but can be more convenient.
