For Churches

8 Ways to Advance Christ-Centered Education

Celebrate Christian Education Sunday

From simple to elaborate, a church can dedicate a Sunday to the importance of Christ-centered education and the role the parent, church, and school play in a child's life.

Backpack Blessings

Collect back-to-school supplies and backpacks for children in need in your congregation or community. Pray over them before distributing them at the beginning of the school year.

Support a Local School

Come alongside a neighborhood school and support them by hosting a fun event or providing needy families with items around the holidays. The ideas are endless!

Host a Homeschool Co-Op

Whether it's hosting a special event like a music festival or a weekly co-op community, opening your facilities could be a simple way to minister to local families.

After-School Program

Set up an after-school program to provide character-building activities and homework tutoring to neighborhood children. Retired teachers or loving volunteers from your congregation could support this effort.

Develop Principal Relationships

Develop relationship with area principals. Offer to pray for them or bless their teacher lounge with snacks. You might be the first call they make if they face a tough situation or know of a family in need.

Start a Christian School

Open your doors Monday–Friday and start a Christian preschool or something more on your church campus. The Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) has timelines and training to walk you through the process at acsi.org/startachristianschool.

What Is Christian Education Sunday?

Christian Education Sunday can be as simple or as complex as you desire anytime at the beginning of your community's school year. We recommend February 2, following National School Choice Week, but you can do what best fits your church and community calendar.

What to Do?

If you create a Christian Education Sunday, use the following suggestions for what to do:

Leading Up to Christian Education Sunday

- Preview the materials found in this tool kit, pray, and talk with your church leadership about what can be done at your church. Even small acts matter. Thank you in advance for your efforts!
- Use graphics found in this tool kit for your church's social media platforms, newsletter, or church bulletin to promote the dedicated date you choose.

Outside of Worship Service

Set up a booth with prayer cards for teachers or students within your congregation. We suggest
only using first names and their grade for student security. You might also want to highlight area
schools (preschool through college) to pray for. You can also use the bookmarks with links for
parents to learn more about educational options.

Inside of Worship Service

- Show the "Faith Teaches" video.
- Have a dedicated prayer time for educators and students in your congregation.
- Allow your children's and youth ministry leads to highlight the ways you serve birth through college in your church.
- Emphasize Christian education through the sermon.
- Allow a local Christian school and/or homeschool co-op to share how they are serving students in your community.

Beyond Christian Education Sunday

• Use the "8 Ways to Advance Christ-Centered Education" to minister to your community all year long.
